

Risk Assessment

Design work is completed in my home office. There are no visitors permitted inside the office. I follow standard health protocols to maintain a safe and healthy workspace.

Site reviews are carried out across the Lower Mainland. I work with a designated site team and with a controlled project portfolio that helps reduce my overall exposure. When I visit project sites I follow the current Provincial Health Protocols (PHO), WorksafeBC guidelines, and the procedures provided by the general contractor.

I identify as immunocompromised. I have received four doses of the COVID-19 vaccine.

Risk Mitigation

I reduce exposure to others by conducting work remotely and digitally where possible.

During on-site work, I maintain safe distance and wear a mask. I follow standard hand washing protocols before and after entering a site.

I limit my exposure environments outside of work.

I maintain open communication with the teams involved within my current project portfolio. Each project is assessed independently and then monitored to mitigate the risks.

This document has been created to meet current provincial recommendations and reflects the current policy for Cavvy Structural Engineering.

Structural engineering is an essential service. I conduct my work with public health and safety in my mind. I continue to do my part to reduce my role in potential exposure or transmission.
